To be eligible for nomination as a Director a member must:

- be in good standing for at least the previous twelve months (1 yr.)
- be nominated by a member in good standing of the applicable local
- have completed the Welcome to PEI UPSE or equivalent course

Deadlines and important information:

- All nominations must be received at UPSE by 4:00 p.m. on **August 1, 2022**
- If necessary, an election will be held by **August 31, 2022**
- A biography **must** be included with the nomination form

Call for nominations: UPSE Secretary Treasurer and Second Vice-President

UPSE's Executive Nominations Committee is calling for nominations for the election of the Secretary Treasurer and the Second Vice-President.

An election for these positions will be held at the union's 60th Annual Convention in November 2022.

As Executive positions, these are two-year terms of office.

Nominations for the positions of Secretary Treasurer and Second Vice-President require the following:

- *nominees must be members in good standing for at least one year*
- *nominations must include signatures of the nominator and seconder (both must be members in good standing)*
- *a biography of the nominee must accompany the nomination form*

The deadline for submitting nomination forms is 4:00 p.m. on Monday, **August 29, 2022**.

If nominations are not received by the deadline, they will also be invited from the convention floor at UPSE's 60th Annual Convention.
