Contact UPSE to register. Tee times are from **12:00 to 2:00 p.m.**

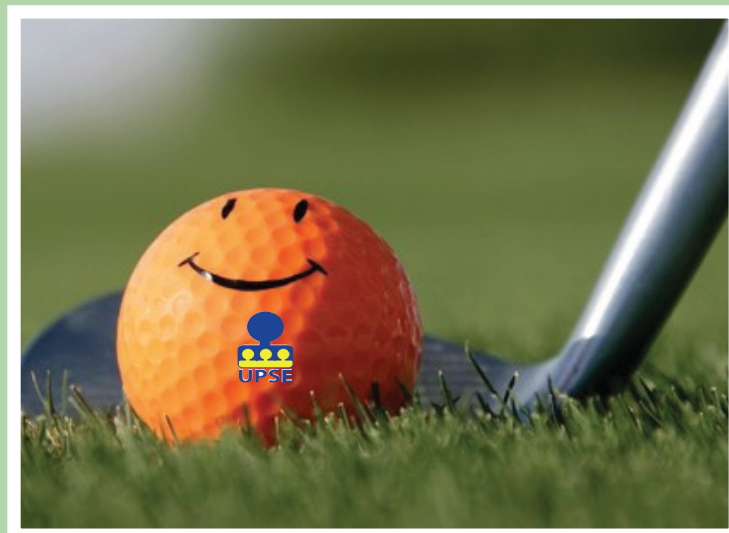
