Directors in odd numbered locals will be running for a twoyear term.

To be eligible for nomination as a Director a member must:

- be in good standing for at least the previous twelve months (1 yr.)
- be nominated by a member in good standing of the applicable local
- have completed the Welcome to PEI UPSE or equivalent course

Deadlines and important information:

- All nominations must be received at UPSE by 4:00 p.m. on August 1, 2023
- If necessary, an election will be held by August 31, 2023
- Nominee biographies MUST be included with nomination forms

Call for nominations: UPSE First and Third Vice-President

UPSE's Executive Nominations Committee is calling for nominations for the election of the First and Third Vice-President.

An election for these positions will be held at the union's 61st Annual Convention in November 2023.


As Executive positions, these are two-year terms of office.

Nominations for the positions of First and Third Vice-President require the following:

- nominees must be members in good standing for at least one year
- nominations must include signatures of the nominator and seconder (both must be members in good standing)
- nominee biographies MUST be included with nomination forms



If nominations are not received by the deadline, they will also be invited from the convention floor at UPSE's 61st Annual Convention.


