### **How to Vote?**

#### Step 1

Only registered members are eligible to Vote. Go to <a href="https://www.peiupse.ca/members/login/">https://www.peiupse.ca/members/login/</a> Your login ID is your UPSE ID. Your password is your POSTAL CODE IN CAPS with a **space** in the middle e.g., (A1A 1A1). After entering your postal code as your password, it will prompt you to immediately change your password. Please save this password for future access to this member's only section.

#### Step 2

**To vote you must Log out and log back in with your new password.** You can now "Cast your Vote" and you will receive a pop-up confirmation message and then a "Thank you for voting" message. This means your vote has been cast properly. If you do not receive a confirmation message or thank you for voting message, your vote has not been registered.
