

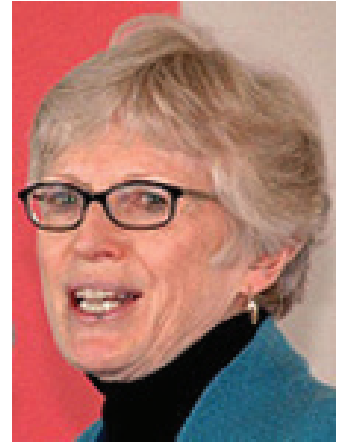
Profiting from Healthcare!

Pat Armstrong knows how important public health care is to Canadians and she is sounding the alarm on privatization. The PEI Health Coalition invites you to attend a lecture entitled "**Profiting from Care; What's the Problem?**" with Dr. Pat Armstrong. She is a distinguished research Professor Emeritus at York University, a prolific writer/author and public speaker.



She serves on the board of the Canadian Health Coalition and the Member's Council of the Canadian Centre for Policy Alternatives, and is a fellow of the Royal Society of Canada.

Her latest book, *Unpaid Work in Nursing Homes: Flexible Boundaries*, looks at unpaid work carried out by residents, relatives, volunteers, and staff in long-term care homes.

Other books of note include:

- *Caring For/Caring About: Women, Home Care and Unpaid Caregiving;*
- *Heal Thyself: Managing Health Care Reform; and*
- *Wasting Away: The Undermining of Canadian Health Care.*

It has been called privatization by stealth. For-profit companies are taking over more and more of Canada's health care system, often with the support of governments in Canada's provinces and territories.
