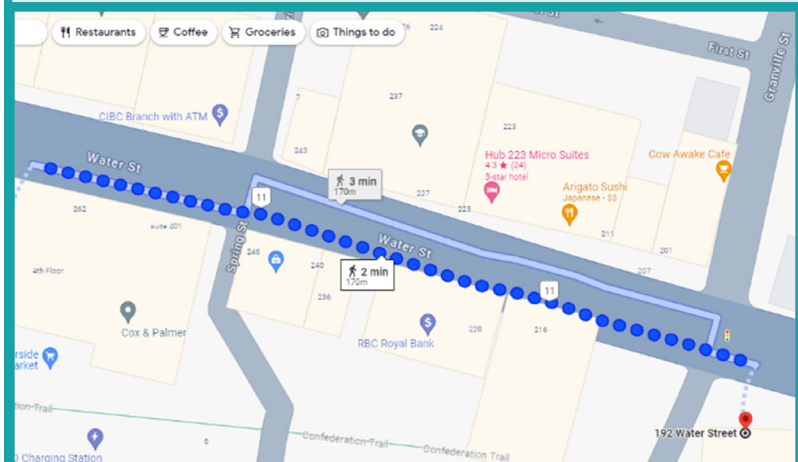
**Location:** 192 Water Street, Summerside
